Grants of up to \$1,000 will be awarded to successful applicants. All grants are solely at the discretion of the Charitable Fund.

Reviewable proposals should meet the following requirements:

- ◆ Proposals must be creative and experimental in nature, and not be for current projects.
- ◆ Proposals must be relationally-centered and outreach-focused.
- ◆ Applicants must be connected to a Christian church or ministry that has 501(c)3 status.
